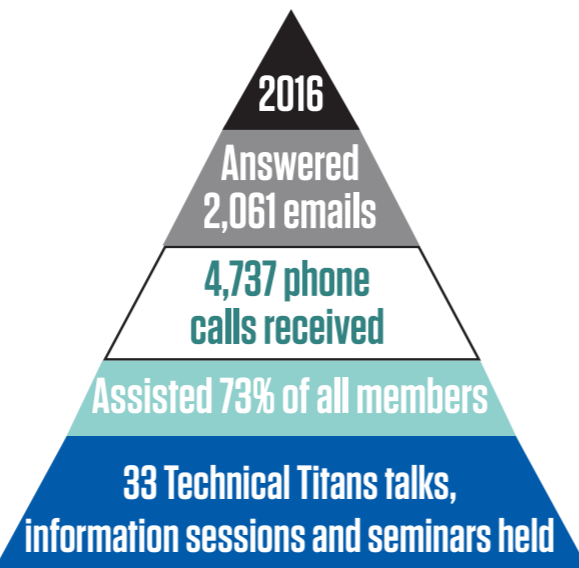

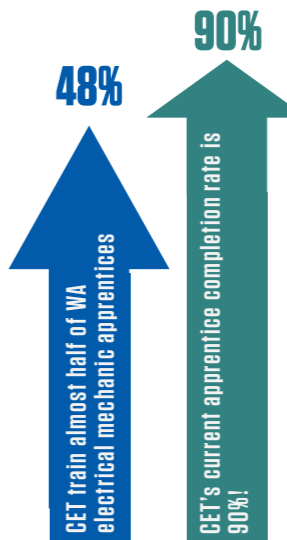

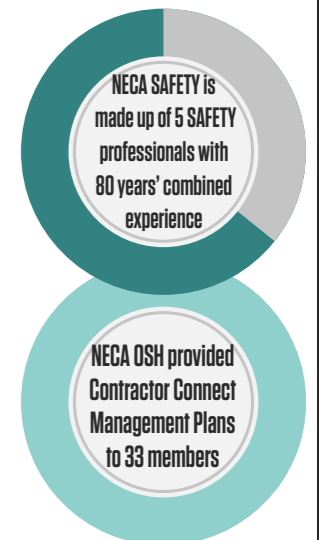


NECA SAFETY

Prepared 46 tailored employment contracts

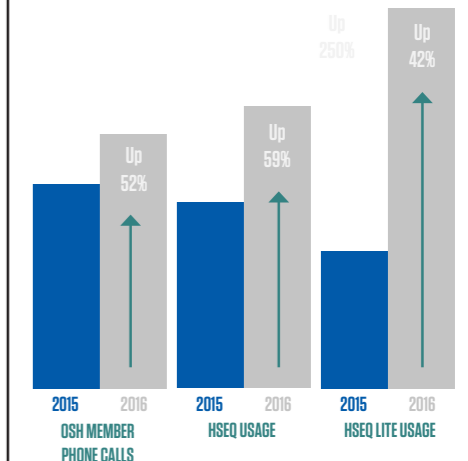
